

Preliminary Meeting Master Thesis and Master Colloquium

Attending a preliminary meeting is obligatory for all those students who would like to start the master thesis in the next semester. Thus, before registering for the master's thesis, you must obtain a supervisory commitment from a qualified supervisor. This is the prerequisite for booking the master thesis module!

Students who wish to submit a Master's thesis in one of the four IKMZ master's programs must attend the Master's Colloquium of the supervising professor. The Master Colloquium provides you with a platform to present and discuss your own research project as well as to critically discuss the projects of others. Whether you book the Master Colloquium in the first or second semester of your master thesis depends on your project. For some projects it makes sense for students to attend the Master Colloquium right at the beginning of the master thesis, for other projects it is more profitable to attend the Master Colloquium towards the end of the master thesis.
